Thank you for your enquiry regarding membership of Childwall Golf Club. Formed in 1912 and host of the Lancashire Amateur Championship in 2021, Childwall Golf Club ranks with the very best courses in the area making it an ideal choice for you to apply to as your home Club.

The course is perfect for golfers of all standards. It is a relatively easy walk with an interesting selection of holes to test the most accomplished golfer. The course design was based on the recommendation of James Braid when the Club moved to its present site in 1938.

We consider there is more to a Golf Club than the course alone, and we have a very active social side to the Club. The Clubhouse has a striking art deco quality. Built in 1938, it was designed by the acclaimed architect Sir Alfred Ernest Shennan (who was also responsible for the Royal Birkdale Clubhouse). Inside there is a well-stocked lounge bar and spike bar, which benefited from a major refit in 2019. Upstairs, the James Braid suite can also play host to a variety of functions, accommodating up to 120, and the Club's Social Committee organises a wide selection of functions during the year.

Our caterers serve excellent food, whether it be a snack at the bar, at one of their theme nights, a social event, or for your own very special private occasion. Plus, what could better than looking over the course, watching the sun set and reflecting what a wonderful Club you've joined.

The application procedure is quite simple. Submit the attached application form to the Club office, which must be supported by a proposer and seconder who have both been full members of the Club for at least 12 months. Applications close and are reviewed on a quarterly basis, prior to interviews being scheduled in January, April, July, and October. Before your interview your application form will be posted on the members' notice board seven days. Following your interview, if your application is accepted, you will be invoiced, and once payment is received, you will be admitted to the Club.
